NEW YORK: Supporting Information for Off-Formulary Exception Request

Pursuant to New York Consolidated Laws - Insurance Law §4903

Determination required within:

- \Box 24 hours (urgent)
- \Box 72 hours

Pursuant to New York <u>Insurance Law §4903</u>, the patient qualifies for an exception to the step therapy protocol because any <u>one</u> of the following conditions has been met:

- □ The required prescription drug is contraindicated or will likely cause an adverse reaction or physical or mental harm.
- \Box The required drug is expected to be ineffective.
- □ The patient has tried the required drug or another drug in the same pharmacologic class or with the same mechanism of action and the drug was discontinued due to a lack of efficacy, effectiveness, diminished effect, or an adverse event.
- \Box The patient is stable on a prescription drug other than the required drug.

□ The required drug is not in the best interest of the patient because the required drug will likely:

□ Cause a significant barrier to the patient's adherence to or compliance with their plan of care;

- \Box Worsen a comorbid condition; or
- □ Decrease the patient's ability to achieve or maintain reasonable functional ability in performing daily activities.
