RE: Support for SB 873 (Prescription drugs: cost sharing)

Dear Chair Holden, Vice Chair Dahle, and members of the California State Assembly Committee on Appropriations –

The Coalition of State Rheumatology Organizations (CSRO) is a national organization composed of over 30 state and regional professional rheumatology societies. CSRO was formed by physicians to ensure excellence and access to the highest quality care for patients with rheumatologic, autoimmune, and musculoskeletal disease.

We are writing today in full support of Senate Bill 873, which would immediately provide cost relief for rheumatology patients by requiring their cost sharing amounts to be reduced by rebates and discounts received by health plans.

Health plans and PBMs receive rebates from manufacturers that reduce the cost of their drugs by a substantial amount. However, our patients are stuck paying cost-sharing based on the list price of a drug rather than the actual price. This system is patently unfair to patients, and it makes treatments more unaffordable than they would otherwise be.

Instead, patients should benefit from the rebates and discounts that they themselves are generating through their medically necessary treatments.

For these reasons, CSRO fully supports SB 873. We appreciate your consideration of our comments.
